INFORMATIVE GUIDE

INTRODUCTION

The information contained in this document is intended for delegates of the CONSTITUTIONAL FORUM ON THE RIGHTS AND GUARANTEES OF YOUNG AFRICAN WOMEN AND CHILDREN, to be held from 2 to 3 February 2026 in Luanda, Angola. The event will be hosted by the Honourable Judge **Laurinda Prazeres, President of the Constitutional Court of Angola.**

RECEPTION OF PARTICIPANTS

Delegations and guests will be received by the organisers in Luanda at the official Protocol Hall of Dr. António Agostinho Neto International Airport, where they will be welcomed.

Subsequently, delegations and guests will be escorted to their accommodation hotel (Intercontinental Hotel), located in the centre of Luanda city.

ENTRY VISA TO ANGOLA

All delegates must present a valid passport upon arrival. Some delegates must be holders of an entry visa, which must be obtained at the Angolan Diplomatic Mission or Consulate in your country.

For countries that do not have Angolan consular missions, the host country will make the necessary arrangements for visas to be obtained upon arrival at the airport. For this purpose, we request that participants send the organisers a copy of their passports, where their biographical data and signatures are visible, as well as a passport-type photograph and a copy of their international vaccination card.

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As some airlines require documentation for passengers to board in the absence of a visa, a letter will be sent to participants who request it, explaining that they are guests of the International Seminar and will obtain their visa in Luanda.

AIRLINES OPERATING IN ANGOLA

The airlines operating in Luanda are:

TAAG, TAP, Emirates, Qatar Airways, Turkish Airlines, Ethiopian Airlines, Air France, Brussels Airlines, Lufthansa, Royal Air Maroc, Airlink, ASKY, Fly Angola and Kenya Airways.

HOTEL ACCOMMODATION

The organisers will provide and cover accommodation for the Head of Delegation and one additional delegate, from Saturday, 31 January until the morning of Wednesday, 4 February 2026, 4 nights.

All other delegates and guests will be accommodated at their own expense at the aforementioned hotel. The hotel will receive a list containing the names of all delegates.

All expenses related to room service, laundry, landline telephone calls, consumption of alcoholic beverages, soft drinks, mini-bar, cigarettes, tips, transportation costs, meals and others, beauty treatments, hairdressing and similar services will be the responsibility of the delegates and unfortunately cannot be covered by the organisers.

DOCUMENTATION

At the hotel, the organisers will provide guests with the Forum kit, which will contain all necessary documents for participation in the event.

At the hotel, a reception area will be operational for accreditation and support to delegates whenever necessary.

VENUE

The Forum will be held within the Intercontinental Hotel Luanda.

Simultaneous translation will be available during the Forum, particularly in: Portuguese, English and French.

COUNTRY

Angola is located on the southwest coast of Africa and borders the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) and the Republic of Congo to the north, Zambia to the southwest, the Republic of Namibia to the south, and the Atlantic Ocean to the west, with an extension of 1,650 km. It has a surface area of 1,246,700 km².

Most of the population, approximately 26 million inhabitants, lives in Luanda, the country's capital. The people are generally friendly and hospitable, welcoming visitors warmly.

In Angola there are two seasons in the year: one hot and rainy - from 15 August to 15 May - and another cooler and dry - from 15 May to 15 August, although humidity is always high.

CLIMATE AND WEATHER

In February, the climate in Luanda is warmer and rainier. During the month of February, Luanda experiences warm sunshine for 6 hours per day.

During the Forum, Luanda will be warmer with average temperatures between 25°C and 30°C.

The length of day in February in Luanda is 12h:22m. The sun rises at 6:10 and sets at 18:32 in the evening.

TRANSPORT

Please note that costs for international transport (flight tickets to Luanda and return) will be the responsibility of the participants.

Local transport to and from Dr. António Agostinho Neto International Airport, between the hotel and the Forum venue and for official events will be provided by the organisers.

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MONEY AND BANKING SERVICES

Banking services are available at all commercial banks. Most banks and hotels have ATMs that accept Visa and MasterCard.

At hotels, banks (there are several in the hotel area) and exchange houses, currency exchange can be made.

TIME ZONE

Angola's time zone is GMT + 1 hour.

VOLTAGE

The voltage in Angola is 220 V AC with a frequency of 50Hz. The sockets used are of the European type.

INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY

Mobile telephone services are provided by Angolan provider companies, some of which have roaming service with other companies. Angolan providers also guarantee internet use, with 3G and 4G technology.

WiFi connection will be available at the hotel.

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HEALTH ADVICE

To enter Angolan territory, it is mandatory to have the yellow fever vaccination certificate.

Here are some recommendations for disease prevention:

- Wash your hands frequently with soap and water, especially before eating.
- Avoid using collective towels.
- Consumption of fish and seafood should only be done in safe restaurants.
- Drink only mineral and/or purified water.
- Do not consume ice, ice cream or sorbets sold on the street.

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MEDICAL EMERGENCY SERVICES

During the duration of the Forum, medical emergency service will be available on site for all Forum delegates, both at the hotel and at nearby clinics.

Delegates are informed to bring their usual medications with them. Should they need any medical consultation or treatment, medications will be paid for by the delegates and participants.



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
